What is WDJD?

- W: Would you consider yourself a good person?
- D: Do you think you've kept the 10 commandments?
- J: Judgment: If God judges you by that standard, would you be innocent or guilty?
- D: Destiny: So what's your eternal destiny going to be? Will you end up in Heaven or Hell when you die?

W: Would you consider yourself a good person?

- Proverbs 20:6 Many a man proclaims his own steadfast love, but a faithful man who can find?
- Jeremiah 17:9-10 The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it? 10 I the Lord search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds.

D: Do you think you've kept the 10 Commandments?

- The 10 Commandments:
 - o 1. Don't have any other gods but God
 - o 2. Don't make idols
 - o 3. Don't take God's name in vain
 - o 4. Keep the Sabbath, a day of rest each week
 - o 5. Honor your parents
 - o 6. Don't murder
 - o 7. Don't commit adultery
 - o 8. Don't steal
 - o 9. Don't bear false witness (lie)
 - o 10. Don't covet (jealously want what someone has)
- Don't murder
 - o Matthew 5:21-22 21 You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgment.' 22 But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.
 - o 1 John 3:15 Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.
- Don't commit adultery
 - Matthew 5:27-28 27 You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
- Don't lie
 - o How many lies do you think you've told your whole life?
- Don't steal
- Don't take God's name in vain blasphemy
- J: Judgment: If God judges you by this standard (10 Commandments), would you be innocent or guilty?
 - James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become guilty of all of it.
- D: Destiny Given that God would judge you guilty, what's your eternal destiny? Will you end up in Heaven or Hell when you die?
 - Revelation 21:8 But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death.

• 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 - 9 Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, 10 nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.

But There is Good News!

- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
- Hebrews 2:9 But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.
- Colossians 2:13-14 13 And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, 14 by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross.
